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Stratton Flats Building Again!

GYPSUM, Colorado — Brian Pauls, of The Pauls Corporation, said that construction at Stratton Flats would start again last spring. And, he has kept his word. So far, two new homes have been sold and five more are under construction..

Stratton Flats originally was to have “appreciation caps” on more than 100 of the proposed 339 homes to be built; however, the deed restrictions were dropped before The Pauls Corporation closed on the deal. Since then, the new owners have taken a good look at the market and determined what kinds of homes are most appropriate for the project. As a result, the homes are a little smaller (about 1,500 square feet with two-car garages and unfinished basements); but with a

decent value — prices for a new home at the development are running around \$235,000. But, “the homes aren't “entry level” houses,” said Ed Small, the project’s new construction and design head, adding that “it’s a misconception that less-expensive homes have to be built cheaper to get to a price.” “This is a nice product for the money,” Small said. “We just needed to do them smaller.”

Bill Holm, the sales and marketing director at Stratton Flats, said that “he’s been impressed with the detail and thought that’s going into the new houses.” And, right now, “there are 100 % loans available for the right buyers,” Holm said.

Homestead and Eagle Country Agree On Open Space!

The “Homestead” development, located in Edwards, Co., is saying “yes, in my backyard” to an Eagle County open space deal. The deal is part of the county commissioners’ plan to spend \$3.2 million from the County’s open space fund on 160 acres of open space next to Homestead. About half the 160 acres are surrounded on three sides by Homestead neighborhoods. The county commissioners unanimously approved an outline for the deal to put at least 120 acres of Homestead’s open space under conservation easement — a conservation easement bans development forever.

“Everyone in Eagle County will benefit from this,” said Peter Runyon, an Eagle County commissioner. The deal also provides public access to Forest Service land, through the open space, for horses, hikers, and mountain bikers.
